Container Deposit Scheme (CDS) Return Point



Return points are reverse vending machines, donation stations, automated depots, or over the counter locations at participating stores.

Containers are sorted



The collected containers are sent to Material Recovery Facilities (MRFs) to be sorted and processed.

Containers become something new!



Sent to reprocessing plant in Australia

Sorted, washed, and shredded into flakes

Made into PET resin used in new bottles and packaging. This keeps it in the loop and out of landfill! **GLASS** Crushed into smaller bits



Sent to reprocessing plant in Australia

Sorted and recycled by colour

Melted to form new bottles and jars. Recycled glass is ready for reuse in less than a month! ALUMINIUM Crushed and Baled



Sold and shipped internationally

Melted down and rolled into sheets

Sheets shaped into new cans. Aluminium can be recycled infinitely!
