Schools Recycle Right 'MultiSort Sign Holder' Design Competition 2025 Terms and Conditions

General

- 1. The Competition is a game of skill. Winners are selected based on the merit of their entry, specifically the creative and artistic skill, accuracy and effectiveness of messaging, and overall quality of the application. Chance plays no part in determining the outcome.
- 2. The material used to market and promote the Competition forms part of these Competition terms and conditions (**Competition Terms**). If there is an inconsistency between the material used to market and promote the Competition and the Competition Terms, the Competition Terms prevail.

Eligibility to enter

- 3. During the Competition period, anyone may enter the Competition, provided that they are:
 - (a) a resident of Australia;
 - (b) of early learning, pre-school, primary school or secondary school age in Australia; and
 - (c) not an employee or Immediate Family Member of the Promoters or an agent of the Promoters who is directly associated with the running of the Competition.

For the avoidance of doubt, a school may enter in its name on behalf of a minor, so long as all other terms and conditions in relation to eligibility are met under this Agreement.

Entering

- 4. By entering the Competition, entrants accept the Competition Terms.
- 5. To enter, entrants must register their school with Planet Ark's "Schools Recycle Right" campaign at recyclingnearyou.com.au/schools-recycle-right and submit their entry within the Competition Period. Entries are to be submitted via JotForm https://form.jotform.com/252847689982077 by a named teacher representing a student, school or class.
- 6. Entrants may only enter once, although schools may enter more than once so long as each entry is in respect of different anonymised students under clause 3.
- 7. The Promoters may deem as invalid any entry which:
 - (a) is illegible, incomprehensible, or incomplete;
 - (b) includes objectionable, offensive, profane, insulting, inflammatory or defamatory material;
 - (c) violates their social media policy or any law or code;
 - (d) is submitted outside the Competition Period; or
 - (e) conflicts with any terms of this Agreement.
- 8. The Promoters may disqualify any entrant who:
 - (a) enters the Competition without being eligible;
 - (b) tampers with the entry process;
 - (c) submits an entry that is not in accordance with the Competition Terms;
 - (d) in entering the Competition, engages in conduct which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Competition or the Promoters; or
 - (e) conflicts with clauses 5, 6 or 7 above.
- 9. Failure by the Promoters to exercise any rights to which it is entitled under clauses 5, 6 or 7 (or any other provision of this Agreement) does not constitute a waiver by it of those rights.
- 10. If the entrant's contact details change, the entrant must notify the Promoters.

Selecting the winner

- 11. The Promoters will select the winner from the pool of valid entrants on the Selection Date.
- 12. The Promoters will select the winner on the basis of creative and artistic skill, accuracy and effectiveness of messaging, and the overall quality of the application. The Promoters' selection is final and binding, subject to the Promoters' rights under clause 7 and clause 8.
- 13. The Promoters will not fund any costs to enable or assist the submission of any entries to this Competition.
- 14. The Promoters will notify the winner by email on or no later than Tuesday 30 November 2025. Notification will additionally be made on the Planet Ark website and on either or both of Planet Ark's Facebook and Instagram channels.

Awarding of Prize

- 15. The Promoters may request that the winner provide proof of identity and proof of residency to the Promoters' reasonable satisfaction before awarding the Prize. If a winner does not provide proof of identity or proof of residency to the Promoters' reasonable satisfaction within 1 month after being selected as a winner, the Promoters may deem the Prize forfeited.
- 16. Winner must accept the Prize by 18 January 2026. If the winner does not accept the Prize by this date, the Promoters may deem the Prize forfeited.
- 17. In consideration of the Promoters awarding the Prize to the winner, the winner:
 - (a) consents to the Promoters using his or her name and/or the name of their school in any marketing and promotion of the Competition, the Promoters or the Promoters' businesses;
 - (b) agrees to use the Prize in accordance with the supplier's specified requirements; and
 - (c) agrees that the Prize is not transferable or exchangeable, and cannot be redeemed for cash or split or swapped for any other item.
- 18. If the Prize is unavailable, the Promoters may substitute the Prize with a substitute prize, provided that the substitute prize is of the same or similar value or specification as the Prize.

Force majeure

19. If there is a Force Majeure Event which prevents or materially and adversely affects the Promoters' ability to market, promote and run the Competition in accordance with the Competition Terms, the Promoters may cancel, terminate, modify, suspend or postpone the Competition.

Liability

- 20. The Promoters are not liable for any loss, expense, damage or liability suffered or incurred by entrants, winner or schools in connection with the Competition, including:
 - (a) any late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected entries or Prize acceptance, including delays due to technical disruptions or network congestion;
 - (b) any incorrect or inaccurate information caused by equipment or programming associated with or utilised in the Competition;
 - (c) any technical error, including any omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission or communications line, telephone, mobile or satellite network failure;
 - (d) any theft, destruction, unauthorised access to or alteration of entries; and
 - (e) any use of the Prize or any tax liability incurred by the winner as a result of their accepting the Prize.

Personal information

21. The Promoters may collect information about entrants and their schools in order to run the Competition, to communicate, award the Prize and comply with the permits. The Promoters use and manage entrants' personal information in accordance with Australian Privacy law. We may also share your personal information with third parties who support us in our marketing or promotional activities. The Promoters will be unable to consider an entry into this Competition if you the entrant does not provide this information. The Promoters will not disclose personal information provided by an entrant unless required or authorised by law.
