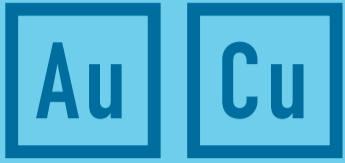

Recoverable Materials

Generally around 95% of materials are recovered from e-waste to make new products.



Starting Fires

Batteries should be kept out of the kerbside recycling bins, they can contain hazardous materials and have the potential to start fires.

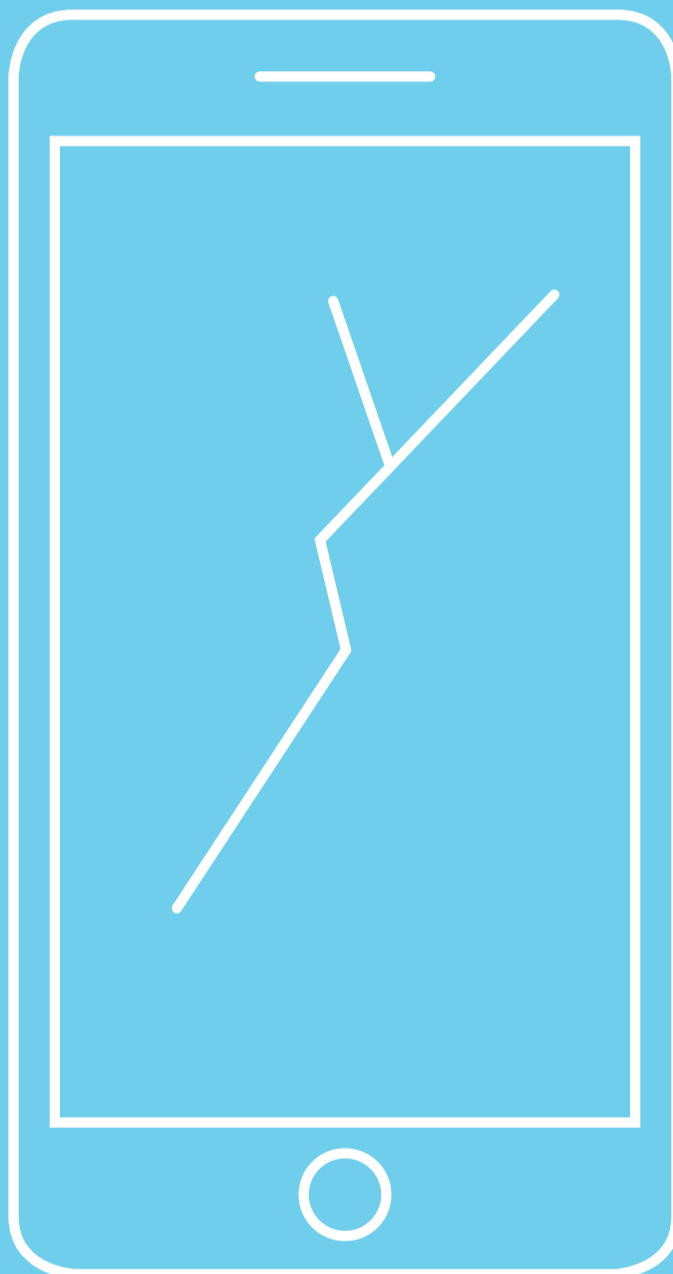
01 REDUCE



Extend the life of your electronics through repair and software upgrades before buying new.



Check if your broken item can be repaired or serviced.



02 REUSE



Buy second-hand or refurbished products.



Pass it on to others by selling, swapping or donating a working device. Remember to clear your data first.

03 RECYCLE
